AT ALLSORTS YOU CAN GET . . .

1 – 2 – 1 support – just book a time with Jim

Confidential advice and information

Confidential screening/testing for sexually transmitted infections (STIs), including HIV (from a visiting health advisor)

Vaccinations against Hepatitis A and B

Chlamydia testing - a simple test is available at any time

Workshops and discussions

Men's group - the group meets every 6 weeks on a Thursday

FREE CONDOMS AND LUBE - these can be found in a tub in the quiet area - and just tell a member of staff if they have run out

**FOR ANY OF THESE SERVICES
ASK JIM OR CHECK OUT THE NOTICE BOARD**

WHY USE CONDOMS? – SOME ADVICE FROM ALLSORTS YOUNG MEN:

- They can protect you against HIV and other STIs when having anal sex
- Around 1 in 7 men on the Brighton scene are HIV positive
- Using one shows you respect yourself and others
 - Carry a condom and lube around with you - don't forget to get some free ones from the Allsorts Drop In

Remember - The age of consent for men to have sex is 16 – as long as both partners agree to it.

Forcing someone to have sex is a crime.
